

RULES

Payment of entry fees indicates the agreement of competitors and spectators not to hold the organisers liable or responsible for any loss, damage or accident incurred by any persons or property on the show field and/or parking field.

Competitors take part entirely at their own risk. It is now compulsory that all riding hats must display a BRC kite mark and to be Standard PAS015 (1988 or 2011) and above. It is essential that all chin straps/safety harnesses must be fastened at all times, when mounted.

It is COMPULSORY for all Junior riders aged 15 years & under to wear body protectors when competing in any jumping classes (show jumping and clear round). It is strongly recommended that body protectors are worn by other age groups, for all classes. Junior riders are NOT ALLOWED to wear spurs in any classes.

NO COLTS or STALLIONS or horses/ponies under 3 years or horse/pony suspected of any illness Are allowed on the showfield. No horse/pony under 4 years can be entered in any ridden classes.

All breaches of the rules, matters of discipline and objections shall be referred to a stewards committee, comprising either the President or Chairman and any two other committee members. Their decision shall be final and binding and shall be notified direct to the person(s) concerned. Bad language will NOT be tolerated on the show field.

Show jumping Ring 1 – Refusals will incur the following penalties: 1st refusal = 4 faults; 2nd refusal = 4 faults and 3rd refusal = elimination. Jumping the wrong course; starting BEFORE the bell and Fall of rider = elimination. **RIDERS ARE NOT ALLOWED** to re-mount in the ring.

Riders must declare to the Collecting Ring Steward BEFORE walking the show jumping course. Only those riders competing in the current class will be permitted in the collecting ring.

NO SPURS ARE ALLOWED in any Junior (15 yrs & under) classes, Mountain & Moorland class and Best Rider classes.

Entries for all classes will be taken on the day. NOT REFUNDABLE.

Late entries MAY be taken at the discretion of the judge.

If you DO NOT wish photographs to be taken of you and/or your family, you must inform our Official Photographer – Charles Waller. Photographs taken by our official photographer may appear in the public domain and on the Club's social media sites to advertise and publicise Ilkley & District Riding Association.

Please ensure that you have removed ALL YOUR LITTER and droppings before you leave. As we borrow the car parking field, the agreement is that it has to be left clear of any rubbish and droppings after our shows. If it is not left to the standard that is required, we could lose this facility – **so please help to maintain our excellent facilities.**

Horses can easily be frightened and can be dangerous. Members of the public are requested to keep clear from horse areas/lanes and to avoid behaviour which might alarm horses. **We strongly advise that horses and ponies are NOT left unsupervised whilst tied up.**

Children **must be supervised** by parents/guardians at all times.

DOGS MUST BE KEPT UNDER CLOSE CONTROL AND ON LEADS AT ALL TIMES. PLEASE CLEAR UP AFTER YOUR DOG AND PLACE IN THE DEDICATED BIN.
