CLASS PLEASE READ ALL THE RULES ESPECIALLY No. 15 (Novice Ruling) ENTRY

RING NO. 1 - JUMPING – WILL START AT 9.00 a.m. PROMPT

CLEAR ROUND (Rosettes awarded) **Rider any age** (Pay at the portacabin) £4
Jumps will not exceed 55cm max. (No spreads) **To be run 9.00 to 9.30 only**

Classes 1 to 11 will be run as 2 round competitions, with a Timed Jump Off

1. **TINY TOTS with Ponies** not exc 138cm. Riders 10 years & under £5
Jumps not to exceed 60cm in first round
2. **INTERMEDIATE PONY** not exc 138cm. Riders 15 years & under (Q15+)(QGR) £5
Jumps not to exceed 65cm in first round
3. **OPEN PONY** not exc 138cm. Riders 15 years & under (Q15+)(QGR) £5
Jumps not to exceed 70cm in first round
4. **IDRA MEMBERS ONLY CLASS** not exc 148cm. Riders 15 years & under £5
Jumps not to exceed 70cm max in first round.
5. **NOVICE PONY** not exc 148cm. Riders 15 years & under (QGR) £5
Jumps not to exceed 70cm in first round
6. **INTERMEDIATE PONY** not exc 148cm. Rider 15 years & under (Q15+)(QGR) £5
Jumps not to exceed 75cm in first round
7. **OPEN PONY** not exc 148cm. **Rider any age.** (Q15+)(QGR) £5
Jumps not to exceed 80cm in first round

THE FOLLOWING CLASSES WILL NOT COMMENCE BEFORE 1.30 pm

- CLEAR ROUND** (Rosettes awarded) **Rider any age** (Pay at the portacabin) £4
Jumps will not exceed 65cm max **To be run for half hour only**
8. **NOVICE HORSE** exceeding 148cm. (QGR) £5
Jumps will not exceed 75cm max in first round
9. **IDRA MEMBERS ONLY CLASS** exceeding 148cm. £5
Jumps not to exceed 75cm in first round
10. **INTERMEDIATE HORSE** exceeding 148cm. (Q15+)(QGR) £5
Jumps not to exceed 85cm in first round
11. **OPEN HORSE** exceeding 148cm. (Q15+)(QGR) £5
Jumps not to exceed 95cm in first round.

SMALL CLEAR ROUND RING - from 10am to 2pm - £2.00 - PAY AT THE RING

Jump height can be changed to suit novice/nervous riders and inexperienced ponies/horses
Rosettes will be awarded for all riders (clear or almost clear)

All JUNIOR riders MUST wear Body Protectors when jumping but NO SPURS

12. ANY PART BRED SHOWING. Any bit. No lead reins	£5
13. RIDDEN HORSE / SPORTS HORSE / EX RACE HORSE An open class for any horse exc.148cm.	£5
14. OPEN SHOWING Not exc. 158cm. No lead reins. Group canter may be split if deemed necessary. (Q15+)	£5
15. OPEN PONY OF SHOW HUNTER TYPE Not exceeding 158cm. No lead reins. Group canter may be split if deemed necessary (Q15+)(QGR)	£5
16. RIDDEN HUNTER / COB / TRADITIONAL COB Exc.142cm (Q15+)(QGR)	£5
17. OPEN RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND - <i>both small & large breeds</i> (Pure bred only to be shown in natural state) (no spurs) (Q15+)(QGR)	£5
18. RIDDEN COLOURED HORSE/PONY (Plaited) Piebald, Skewbald, Roan, Palomino, Dun, Spotted, etc. (Q15+)(QGR)	£5
19. RIDDEN COLOURED HORSE/PONY (Traditional) Piebald, Skewbald, Roan, Palomino, Dun, Spotted, etc. (Q15+)(QGR)	£5
20. RIDDEN VETERAN HORSE exc. 148cm (15 years & over) (no spurs) (Q15+)(QGR)	£5
21. RIDING CLUB HORSE/PONY To include one or two small jumps. All juniors must wear a body protector and no spurs. (Q15+)	£5

RIDDEN RING CHAMPIONSHIP (Rule 25 applies)

1st placed only from Classes 12 to 21 (please wear your rosette) - no show required

It is each winner's responsibility to be ready at Ring 2 as soon as Class 21 finishes.

We have a very tight schedule to keep and cannot hold this presentation up for any reason.

Please remember that you can only use a riding crop / showing cane / whip that does not exceed 70cm (30 inches) in Any Class in Any Ring – Rule 8

Please note: Following a rider / equine fall; riders are not allowed to re-mount during any class, in any ring, under any circumstances.

RING 2 - AFTERNOON - WORKING HUNTER CLASSES
Will not start before 1.30 p.m.

**All JUNIOR riders MUST wear Body Protectors when jumping
(both in and outside the Show Rings) and NO SPURS ALLOWED**

WORKING HUNTER CLASSES. May be ridden in any bit and judged on:-

Phase 1 – Jumping 50%, style & manners 20%

Phase 2 – Conformation, freedom of movement & type/breed type (M & M) 20%, manners 10%.
Working Mountain & Moorland ponies compete on an equal basis.

Penalties – Knockdown = 10 faults; 1st refusal = 15 faults; 2nd refusal = 20 faults; 3rd refusal = elimination;
Wrong course = elimination. Fall of horse/pony & rider = elimination.

Riders are NOT allowed to remount after a fall

In all working hunter classes – if we have very large entries, we hold the right to only call back in, for Phase 2, a number of horses or ponies that have achieved the best Phase 1 marks to allow completion of classes at a sensible time – at the judge's discretion.

22. **BEGINNERS STAKES** – not exc 133cm. (*No spurs allowed*) £5
Fences not to exceed 40cm. Rider 15 yrs & under. Riders may be on a lead rein for the jumping phase but must show on the same basis. Penalties to be accrued for both pony and handler (who **must** wear a hard hat).
Lead Rein Riders CAN enter Class 23 as well but no more WH classes.
23. **TRAINING STAKES** – Open to any horse or pony (*No spurs allowed for juniors*) £5
Fences not to exceed 50cm. Riders may be on a lead rein for the jumping phase but must show on the same basis. Penalties to be accrued for both pony and handler (who **must** wear a hard hat). **The Bank may be included and all competitors are expected to complete the full course.**
24. **WORKING HUNTER - Open to any horse or pony** £5
Fences not to exceed 60cm. (*No spurs allowed for juniors*)
25. **MIXED HEIGHT MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND WORKING HUNTER (pure bred)** £5
(Natural state only) To be judged as ONE class (No spurs allowed) (QGR)
Same course for both sections only the height is changed for Large Breeds.
- (a) **Small Breeds** (Welsh A & B, Dartmoor, Exmoor & Shetland).
Fences not to exceed 55cm.
- (b) **Large Breeds** (Welsh C & D, New Forest, Connemara, Fell, Highland & Dales)
Fences not to exceed 70cm.

Plse note: When Large Breeds have started, NO LATE Small Breeds will be allowed to compete

26. **WORKING HUNTER - Open to any horse or pony** £5
Fences not to exceed 70cm. (*No spurs allowed for juniors*)
27. **WORKING HUNTER - Open to any horse or pony** £5
Fences not to exceed 85cm. (*No spurs allowed for juniors*) (QGR)
28. **WORKING HUNTER - Open to any horse or pony** £5
Fences not to exceed 1M. (*No spurs allowed for juniors*) (QGR)

WORKING HUNTER RING CHAMPIONSHIP (Rule 25 applies)

1st placed only from Classes 22 to 28 (please wear your rosette) - no show required

It is each winner's responsibility to be ready at Ring 2 as soon as Class 28 finished

29. TACK & TURNOUT. Any height and rider any age. Riders 8 years & under may be led with lead rein attached to the noseband. To be judged on cleanliness and neatness of horse/pony and rider. (QGR)	£5
30. BEGINNER'S WALK & TROT ONLY. To be ridden in a snaffle bridle. Any height & rider any age. Not to have been placed in <u>any ridden</u> class prior to 1 st January of the competing year in question at any venue. No lead reins.	£5
31. LEAD REIN / FIRST RIDDEN SHOWING (Plaited) Not exc.133cm. To be ridden in a snaffle bridle. Riders 12 years & under. Riders 8 years & under may be led with lead rein attached to the noseband. Rosettes to all. (Q15+)(QGR)	£5
32. LEAD REIN / FIRST PONY OF SHOW HUNTER TYPE. (Plaited) Not exc. 133cm. To be ridden in a snaffle bridle. Riders 12 years & under. Riders 8 years & under may be led with lead rein attached to the noseband. Rosettes to all. (Q15+)(QGR)	£5
33. LEAD REIN / FIRST RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND (pure bred) Not exc. 133cm. To be ridden in snaffle bridle. Riders 12 years & under. Riders 8 years & under may be led with lead rein attached to the noseband. No spurs and to be shown in natural state. Rosettes to all. (Q15+)(QGR)	£5

ALL EQUITATION CLASSES (*Snaffle bridles with cavesson or drop noseband and no spurs. Judged solely on the rider's ability*)

34. EQUITATION - Riders 13 years & over	£5
35. EQUITATION - Riders 12 years & under. No lead reins	£5

NOVICE EQUITATION CLASS Rider and horse/pony combination **NEVER** having won a first prize/first rosette in any equitation class prior to 1st January of the competing year in question **at any venue.**

36. NOVICE EQUITATION - Any height and rider any age. Riders 8 years & under may be led with a lead rein attached to the nose band.	£5

RIDDEN RING CHAMPIONSHIP (Rule 25 applies)

1st placed only from Classes 31 to 36 (please wear your rosette) - no show required

It is each winner's responsibility to be ready at Ring 3 as soon as Class 36 finishes.

We have a very tight schedule to keep & cannot hold this presentation up for any reason.

Please remember that you can only use a riding crop / showing cane / whip that does not exceed 70cm (30 inches) in Any Class in Any Ring – Rule 8

Please note: Following a rider / equine fall; riders are not allowed to re-mount during any class, in any ring, under any circumstances.

RING NO. 3 - AFTERNOON

Will not start before 1.00 pm

All JUNIOR riders MUST wear Body Protectors when jumping on this showground but NO SPURS allowed in any classes

37. RIDDEN FAMILY HORSE OR PONY Exceeding 138cm. To be suitable and safe for riding by an adult and child. No lead reins and must be ridden in a snaffle bridle. No spurs.	£5
38. RIDDEN CHILD'S FIRST PONY (Snaffle bridle only) Not exceeding 138cm. First child's pony to be suitable to teach a child to ride. The quality of the pony will not be taken into consideration. May be on or off the lead rein (for riders 8 years & under). No spurs. Rosettes to all entrants.	£5
39. NOVICE SHOWING (Snaffle bridle only). Any height and rider any age. Rider and horse/pony combination NEVER to have won a first prize/first rosette in any showing class, prior to 1 st January of the competing year in question at any venue . No spurs. No lead reins.	£5
40. RIDDEN VETERAN PONY not exc 148cm. (15 years & over) No spurs. (Q15+)(QGR)	£5

RIDDEN RING CHAMPIONSHIP (Rule 26 applies)

1st placed only from Classes 37 to 40 (please wear your rosette) - no show required

It is each winner's responsibility to be ready at Ring 3 as soon as Class 40 finishes.
